## SKILLS COVERED

- Create large rings/circles to form base of necklace.
- Texture using hammers and metal stamps.
- Solder jump ring & multiple jump rings using two different methods.
- Solder chain to inner circle necklace using third hand.
- Use of sandpaper, metal files and liver of sulfur for finish work.
- Safety

## CLASS INCLUDES

- 17" sterling silver cable chain
- 1 sterling silver clasp
- 4 sterling silver jump rings
- 8" 16 gauge sterling silver round wire
- Hard, medium and easy solder
- All tools
